

Architectural Millwork/Cabinetmaker

Fabricators work under the direction of the Shop Foreman and are responsible for fabrication, finish and assembly of millwork & exhibit components. Fabricators are members of the shop staff and must meet objectives and deadlines.

Role priorities:

- Fabricates, inspects, repairs, installs, modifies and refurbishes woodwork and exhibit related structures.
- Is an integral part of a production team of skilled craftsmen.
- Communicates, coordinates and collaborates with the Shop Supervisor.
- Familiarity of materials, methods, and tools in relation to safety and operation.

Main responsibilities:

- Responsible for the fabrication of finished millwork and exhibit components.
- Cooperates with the foreman and shop staff to ensure a safe and efficient workplace.
- Communicates with the Foreman and Supervisor to assess progress and meet objectives.

Qualifications:

- Ability to read blueprints and communicate effectively within the shop environment.
- Familiarity with the operation of tools and techniques in the fabrication and production of millwork and it's installation.
- Understanding of various materials, fabrication, finish, and assembly of exhibits and millwork.
- Understand the nature of fabrication, finish and assembly of trade show exhibits.
- Excellent technical skills, with the ability to explain ideas and concepts.

- Familiar and competent with a variety of common shop tools, CNC and the ability to embrace emerging technology.
